What is the Endowment Fund?

The ORLC Endowment Fund was formed in 2020 to encourage, receive, and manage gifts for the mission and work of the Church. The fund will allow people to designate mission and ministry projects they want to support. Gifts and bequests given to the Endowment Fund will be carefully managed according to the wishes of the donor. The Endowment Fund committee is elected by the Voters. The Fund allows you to have a say in what your gifts will accomplish even after your death.

Why should I make a gift to the Endowment Fund?

The Endowment Fund provides a means for us as Christian stewards to demonstrate and express in a tangible way our deep gratitude for God's many gifts and blessings to us. A gift to the Endowment Fund is a reflection of our faith and Christian love over and above our regular support for the ongoing mission and ministry of Our Redeemer Lutheran Church. Our Redeemer Lutheran Church is a qualified charity according to the Internal Revenue Service and contributions are tax deductible.



How can I participate in the ORLC Endowment Fund's Activities?

There any many ways, depending on your desires and your financial resources. The more common methods include:

Direct Gifts

A gift of cash, stocks, bonds, real estate or personal property can be given outright.

Bequests in a Will

Through a Will, a person may make a gift of a specific asset, or a percentage of an estate, or a stated dollar amount.

Life Insurance

A gift of life insurance can be made to the Endowment Fund to help support the needs of the donor and future needs of the Endowment Fund.

Trust Agreement

A Trust may be created by a donor to provide income and principal to help support ministries through the Endowment Fund.

Remembrance Giving

Gifts may be given in memory of loved ones or friends.
